ETS - Time to start thinking about emissions returns

We will be posting out letters to all our ETS post-1989 registered clients in December, seeking instructions to submit a voluntary emissions return (VER) for 2014 (or 2013-2014 if nothing was submitted for 2013). Voluntary emissions returns are accepted by MPI between January and June each year.

While the price of an NZU hasn't moved much since the election – current indicative price around \$4.15 – some commentators expect there may be some upward movement after May 2015. **If you claim and receive your entitlement of units into your holding account, you have options should any opportunities arise.**
